Appropriation Ordinance

Dear President of Board of Commissioners:

Attached please find the proposed Appropriation Ordinance for the 2015-2016 fiscal year. Illinois State Law requires the ordinance to be passed by the Riverdale Park Board before the last day of July 2015. The Appropriation Ordinance is the first step of a two-step funding process. The Appropriation Ordinance provides the authority of the Park to expend public monies for park functions and sets an upper limit of the spending. The second part of the funding process is the Levy Ordinance. The Levy Ordinance is generally passed in the fall. Once passed, the Levy Ordinance is filed with the county and directs the county to levy real estate taxes on real estate within the park district.

A draft version of the ordinance must be on file for public inspection 30 days prior to passage. The Riverdale Park Board must hold a Public Hearing on the proposed budget and Appropriation Ordinance prior to passing the ordinance. I would recommend the Board of Commissioners review the ordinance at the June meeting, and direct that the hearing be scheduled for the July meeting. At that time, the hearing could be held and the ordinance passed.

SECTION IV: The receipts and the revenues of the said Riverdale Park District derived from sources other than taxation and not specifically appropriated, and all unexpended balances from the preceding fiscal year not required for the purpose for which they were appropriated and levied shall constitute the General Fund and shall first be placed to the credit of such fund.

SECTION V: That all unexpended balances of any item or items of any general appropriation made in this ordinance be expended in making up for any insufficiency in any item or items in the same general appropriation for the same general purpose or any like appropriations made by this ordinance.

SECTION VI: That all unexpended balances of annual appropriations of previous years are hereby reappropriated.

SECTION VII: That the Riverdale Park District requests that the County Clerk of Cook County use a loss rate of 20% for bond and interest funds, and a loss rate of 20% for all remaining funds in extending this tax levy.

SECTION VIII: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
